Introduction

In late November 2014, most of the 200 Australian Special Forces Task Group personnel [were relocated](#) from Al Minhad Air Base in the UAE to the Baghdad Diplomatic Security Centre in the Baghdad Airport Precinct. At that point the SATG was conducting assistance for close air support of Iraqi operations, and was [preparing to move](#) to forward operating bases with their assigned Iraqi Security Force partners in Iraqi Counter-Terrorism Services.
