1. Purpose. To promulgate a list of those recurring reports required by CINCPACFLT from the operating forces of the U. S. Pacific Fleet. Enclosure (1) has been revised in its entirety.

2. Cancellation. CINCPACFLTINST 5213.5P.

3. Contents. Enclosure (1) contains a list of recurring reports required by CINCPACFLT, issued in accordance with references (a) and (b). Reports not listed in enclosure (1) are cancelled. Directives listed in enclosure (1) that require reports and do not have the statement "Approved for three year period" are hereby approved for a three year period from the date of this instruction.

4. Code Explanations

a. Requiring Directives. References under the heading "Directive(s)" are to be considered as referring to the latest effective revision thereof.

b. Frequency Code Letters. The following is an interpretation of the frequency code letters used in enclosure (1):

W - Weekly	A - Annually
M - Monthly	SIT - Situational
Q - Quarterly	OT - Other
SA - Semiannually	

c. Electrical Transmission under Communications Condition MINIMIZE. When a report is to be received during MINIMIZE conditions, the words (MIN: CONSIDERED) are written in parenthesis after the report/control symbol; for example, CINCPACFLT Report 1010-1 (MIN: CONSIDERED).

5. Reports Control Symbol. Since the symbol assigned to a report is used for its identification, all future reports submitted, as required by enclosure (1), shall bear the designated Report Symbol number listed in the "Report Symbol" column of enclosure (1). The applicable symbol number shall be inserted in the report as follows:

a. On letter reports - in parentheses after the subject, e.g., "SOAP Deficiency Funding (CPF Report 4441-4)."

b. On form reports - in the upper right corner of the first page.

c. On message/speedletter reports - as subject of message/speedletter. In cases of short reports, at the beginning of the text.

6. Action

a. Addressees shall maintain a reports control program within their commands in accordance with reference (a).

b. Addressees shall issue a single consolidated list of recurring reports required of ships and units under their administrative commands, including those published by enclosure (1) to this instruction.
