**Nautilus Staff Discuss North Korean Energy Issues at World Affairs Council**  
November 11, 2000

Nautilus staff held a half-day seminar at the World Affairs Council in San Francisco on Nov. 10 to discuss the Institute's work on North Korea and its relation to regional energy and security issues. Nautilus Institute Executive Director (Dale Hays), Senior Associate (Jim Thomas), Security Program Officer for Northeast Asia (Linda Savage), Research Associate (Chris Cassano) and Energy Researcher (Maura Schmitt) discussed the work. World Affairs Council President (Jim Hays) acted as moderator, and invited four speakers on the U.S. National Security Council during the 1997-1998 North Korean nuclear crisis.

This seminar was sponsored by a grant from the Korea Foundation. A portion of the seminar will be broadcast by KQED-TV in the San Francisco Bay Area on January 22, 2001, and subsequently by National Public Radio stations nationwide.
