**The APEC & the Environment Project**, active between 1992-1999, aimed to define and promote a regional sustainable development agenda within the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation forum. The Project generated research papers, organized workshops of regional analysts and activists, and produced *Connectivity Monitor*, an on-line regional environmental news round-up. Lyuba Zarsky also served on the US delegation to two APEC Environment Ministerials.
