Professor Michael Hamel-Green is Dean of the Faculty of Arts, Education and Human Development, Victoria University, Melbourne, Australia. His research has focussed on regional disarmament, nuclear-weapon-free zones, and regional security issues, particularly in the Asia Pacific. He has been a visiting researcher at the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research in Geneva has conducted research for the Nautilus Institute on Northeast Asian nuclear weapon free zone proposals; and has contributed the entries for the new Oxford Encyclopaedia of Peace on regional denuclearized zones, Pacific nuclear testing, and multilateralism. He has recently published an overview of denuclearized zone initiatives for UNIDIR's Disarmament Forum 2011 special issue on these zones; as well as articles on the Arctic NWFZ and Northeast Asian NWFZ proposals. Michael has long been active in peace and disarmament movements in Australia.
