Assignment/Departure of Flag/General Officers

(U) There were four flag/general officer changes during 1973. On 1 August 1973 General Richard G. Stilwell, USA, received the command of United Nations Command/United States Forces Korea (UNC/USFK) from General Donald V. Bennett, USA.

(U) Lieutenant General John R. Murphy, USAF, replaced Lieutenant General Robert N. Smith, USAF, as Chief of Staff, HQ UNC/USFK, on 30 September 1973.

(U) There were two changes in the TDY position Senior Member, United Nations Military Armistice Commission. Major General Fred E. Haynes, USMC, replaced Major General Rollen H. Anthis, USAF, and served from 6 February 1973 to 12 August 1973. General Haynes was replaced by Brigadier General (P) Thomas U. Greer, USA, who served from 13 August 1973 through the end of the year.

CHAPTER II: PERSONNEL (U)

1. (C) Eighth Army Strength Posture. During the period 1 Nov 72 to 30 Jun 73, Eighth Army assigned strength went from a low of 95.3 percent (29,471) of authorized strength in Jan to a peak of 104.3 percent (32,366) in Apr. Authorized strength was 30,964 on 1 Nov 72 and 31,073 on 30 Jun. Officer assigned strength has been over 100 percent of the Projected Requisitioning Authorization (PRA), for the entire reporting period. However, the PRA severely limited the number of field grade officers (70 percent of majors and lieutenant colonels) the command was authorized to requisition. PRA-imposed shortages heavily limited assignment of officers in the Adjutant General, Engineer, Finance, Military Intelligence, Quartermaster and Signal Corps branches, while significant shortfalls exist in the number of Infantry and Field Artillery officers in the command. Enlisted strength remained above authorization for the reporting period, although critical EM MOS shortages exist.¹ Eighth Army lost 153 officers in Jun due to the Army-wide reduction in force (RIF). Four majors, 117 captains, and 34 lieutenants were affected. The 2d Infantry Division had the highest attrition (58 officers) followed by USAKORSCOM (31 officers). By branch, the Infantry (48) and Field Artillery (26) were most affected by the RIF.

2. (U) Modern Volunteer Army (MVA) Summary. The DA MVA Program was terminated in May. On 5 Jun the Eighth Army Commander directed that the concept continue to function as the Eighth Army Improvement Program in order to further the momentum established under MVA. Major command actions directed at strengthening professionalism are as follows:

- a. Korean nationals were employed to the greatest possible extent in maintenance and housekeeping positions in order to free the maximum number of soldiers for mission requirements and training.
- b. Adventure Training continued to receive enthusiastic support.² Fifteen members of the command qualified as parachutists on completion of a rugged three-week training program given by the 1st Special Forces Group on Okinawa while the 2d Infantry Division embarked on a Spartan Training Program which has elicited favorable response from participants and observers.
- c. Improvement of soldier education received much emphasis. The command stressed the professional and civilian educational opportunities available, to include: the St. Louis High School PREP; Transition Training courses; Los Angeles City College Professional Degree Program; and MOS-related job improvement courses.³

13. (C) Revision of Eighth Army Noncombatant Emergency and Evacuation (NEMVAC) OPLAN 5060 (U). The revision of OPLAN 5060, begun in Dec 71, was published in draft form during May 72. Major changes included were:

- a. Tasking of subordinate commands in accordance with their capabilities.
- b. A detailed concept of evacuation for the movement of noncombatants within and from the ROK.
- c. Use of the new Joint Operational Planning System (JOPS) format.
- d. Preparation of detailed functional personnel, logistics and signal annexes to support the evacuation concepts.

The draft OPLAN 5060 and a draft Eighth Army Noncombatant Relocation and Evacuation Control Center (NORECC) SOP were exercised during CPX CAPABLE TEAM VI and CPX FOCUS LENS FY 73. As a result, the draft plan was reevaluated by Eighth Army staff sections and subordinate commands to incorporate the lessons learned. The final OPLAN 5060 was staffed and approved by the Eighth Army CofS for publication on 10 Apr. This plan includes the NORECC SOP which provides the headquarters with an updated SOP for the organization, functions, assigned responsibilities and procedures for the activation and operation of the NORECC upon commencement of a noncombatant evacuation. CINCPAC approved the OPLAN and NORECC SOP on 31 May. All major subordinate commands were required to submit supporting plans prior to 30 Jun.

14. (C) Eighth Army Participation in Operation HOMECOMING (Formerly EGRESS RECAP) (U). In Dec 71 COMUSKOREA directed the development of an OPLAN which implemented the requirements of revised DOD, JCS and CINCPAC policy guidance concerning the processing of returnees after release/repatriation/escape from foreign control. COMUSKOREA was charged by CINCPAC to exercise initial control and initiate the processing of returnees in the ROK.⁷ The operation, formerly called EGRESS RECAP, was changed to Operation HOMECOMING per 8 Jan direction of the Secretary of Defense. In the USARPAC OPLAN, Eighth Army was tasked to render such personnel, administrative, logistical, transportation, and facility support as required by COMUSKOREA.⁸ Additionally, the Eighth Army Commander was to be prepared to provide augmentation personnel to the Joint Central Processing Center (JCPC) in Okinawa and escort officer/NCO personnel as directed by CINCUSARPAC. These specific requirements resulted in this headquarters further tasking USAKORSCOM to provide 15 MPs (MOS 95B) as a security force augmentation, who were then placed in a readiness posture with deployment possible within eight hours of notification. An additional Eighth Army requirement consisted of providing three personnel to help staff the Joint Information Bureau (JIB). When the returnees were released, Okinawa was not utilized and only the Clark AFB, Philippines, JCPC was activated. Accordingly, Eighth Army participation consisted of furnishing four personnel from the Public Affairs Office to help staff the Clark JIB.⁹

CHAPTER III: INTELLIGENCE (U)

1. (C) North Korean (NK) Activity. A statistical summary of agent apprehensions is shown below:

2. (C) Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) Incidents.

a. Military Demarcation Line (MDL) Team. On 7 Mar, 51 ROK EM and nine officers were working on MDL markers in the vicinity of CT 6135 when at 1314 hours two rounds of small rounds fire were received from NK guard post (GP) 560 (CT 615435). The ROK troops began an immediate withdrawal. Then at 1321 hours NK GP 559 (CT 614431) fired four rounds of small arms fire, killing one ROK captain and wounding a staff sergeant in the leg. The wounded NCO was evacuated, but the officer's body could not be reached for six hours. During the withdrawal of the team from the area, covering smoke and high explosives were fired by friendly 105mm gun batteries and by 60mm mortars. A 24-man force remained in the area for security. At 1510 hours friendly GP 512 fired an unknown number of .50 caliber rounds into the air as a warning measure. At 1525 hours a six-man task force was organized to recover the captain's body. As they approached the corpse, NK GP 559 fired an unknown number of rounds of small arms fire. At that time the friendly unit began broadcasting, "Stop firing, we are trying to bring back wounded personnel." Due to the firing from NK GP 559, the task force was unable to move closer than five meters from the captain's body, and a ROK sergeant was wounded in the stomach and died at 1623 hours. At 1940 hours personnel were able to evacuate the dead captain to friendly GP 512. No enemy casualties were reported in this first fatal DMZ incident since 17 Sep 71.

b. DMZ Infiltrators. At 2340 hours on 17 Apr, personnel from the 28th Recon Co, 28th ROK Infantry Division, who were manning an ambush position in the UNC portion of the DMZ (CT 239268), fired on an undetermined number of infiltrators. The ambush patrol, consisting of one officer and nine EM,

Unit provided an interchange of ideas concerning the problems and needs of command personnel; the five Christian Servicemen's Centers afforded the hospitality and atmosphere conducive to improved morale for US servicemen; the Eighth Army Religious Retreat Center in Seoul furnished weekly denominational and ecumenical programs in conjunction with its spiritual R&R concept; and the Korean Welfare Branch received and distributed packages to local organizations, such as the Holt Adoption Agency and St. Paul's Orphanage.

b. The Public Information Program continued with daily broadcasts over the American Forces Korea Network (AFKN) of a five-minute morning devotional, Sunday broadcasts of worship services at Eighth Army Memorial Chapel, and weekly publication of religious articles in the Pacific Stars and Stripes.

c. In the operations and administration areas, the following actions were reported during the eight-month period:

(1) The ASCOM Chapel terminated services 1 Jun as a result of the installation closure.

(2) The senior chaplains of the 19th and 23d Support Groups and the 2d Transportation Group came under the direct supervision of the Eighth Army Chaplain, effective 30 Jun, due to the HQs Eighth Army/KORSCOM merger.

(3) The Camp Carroll Depot, US Army Garrison, Yongsan and I Corps (ROK/US) Group Special Troops were each authorized an additional chaplain position, raising the PRA for chaplains in Eighth Army to 49.






